*Pastor Mark's Remarks – November 2024**"Time to Flow Together"*

I may be wrong, but it seems to me that the Christians in America have a disproportionately small impact on our society based on our proportion of the population. We could be flowing together as a mighty stream of God's kingdom bringing life and healing to our society, but instead of flowing deep and wide together, we trickle as a bunch of narrow, shallow streams which only make minimal impact on our culture.

The time to keep our distance and criticize what we don't like about other streams of the church needs to be over. The time to flow together, the strengths of each stream coming together to benefit everyone, has come.

Starting November 17 we will be focusing on the major streams of Christianity. As Lutherans we tend to contain much of some of these streams and little of the others. The fact of the matter is, that Jesus represented ALL these streams in his ministry, and it will only be when all the streams come together that the world will see the fullness of Jesus through his church.

The streams we will be focusing on are:

1. Contemplative/Prayer-filled life
2. Holiness/Virtuous life
3. Charismatic/Spirit-empowered life
4. Social Justice/Compassionate life
5. Evangelical/Word-centered life
6. Incarnational/Sacramental life

Which one is most like Jesus and the Bible? All of them

I can learn from my friend who enjoys spending time with God to enjoy spending time with God myself.

I can learn from my friend who lives a holy life by living according to God's ways to live a more holy life.

I can learn from my friend who manifests the power of God through the gifts of the Holy Spirit to desire and experience more of God's power at work in and through me.

I can learn from my friend who actively works to lift up the downcast and bring justice to the world how to become a better advocate for a just society.

I can learn from my friend who believes in the power of God's word to change lives to value and more freely proclaim God's word in my daily life.

I can learn from my friend who experiences God meeting them in their weakness in the context of their daily life to do the same in my life.

More friends from more of the streams regularly coming together will raise the water level for everyone!

The fact of the matter is that all the streams reveal important aspects of Jesus. You don’t need to read the book to get a lot out of the series, but it is a well-written book which is well worth your time. Pastor Mark will be ordering books November 4 so they will be in by November 10. The cost will be about \$10.

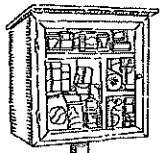

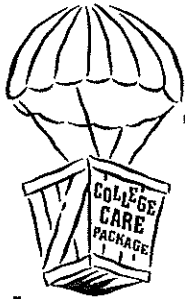
