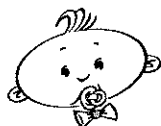

Pentecost 2025

June 8 – Nov 23

Red is the color used on Pentecost Sunday. On this day we remember the power and fire of the Holy Spirit, "the Lord and Giver of Life." The color red communicates the motif of strength – the strength and power the Holy Spirit gives in order for God's people to call on the name of Jesus Christ and share that powerful name with others.

Pentecost begins fifty days after Easter. The season of Pentecost may last from 22 to 28 Sundays. Green is the appointed color for all but a few of these Sundays. The Sundays following Pentecost are called the season of the "green meadow," as these Sundays also emphasize the subject of growth.

LifeWise Bible Classes in Yukon and Mustang School Districts - Pastor Mark has been part of the steering committees to start Bible classes for students in the Yukon and Mustang school districts. Our present status in the schools:

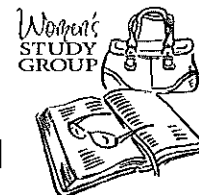
Yukon – The program has been approved, and we are in the process of hiring a local program director. It will start at one school (Parkland Elementary) where the students will cross the street to Town and Country Christian Church for class. We hope to be adding more schools as meeting sites become available.

Mustang – In Mustang, there is a steering committee formed which is starting to explore possibilities.

What is LifeWise, and how can they do Bible Classes for Public Schools?

1. LifeWise is a non-profit based in Ohio that has begun Bible classes in over 1000 school districts across the country. They focus on the aspects of faith that unite the church rather than lifting up what divides.
2. Federal law says public schools must provide an opportunity for Bible classes for students as long as the following criteria are met:
 - a. During the school day
 - b. Off-site
 - c. Parent-approved
