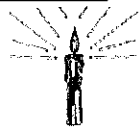

Pentecost 2025

June 8 – Nov 23

Red is the color used on Pentecost Sunday. On this day we remember the power and fire of the Holy Spirit, “the Lord and Giver of Life.” The color red communicates the motif of strength – the strength and power the Holy Spirit gives in order for God’s people to call on the name of Jesus Christ and share that powerful name with others.

Pentecost begins fifty days after Easter. The season of Pentecost may last from 22 to 28 Sundays. Green is the appointed color for all but a few of these Sundays. The Sundays following Pentecost are called the season of the “green meadow,” as these Sundays also emphasize the subject of growth.

Pastor Mark's Remarks for August 2025***"Help Wanted: Our Presence, not our Absence"***

21 For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain. 22 If I am to go on living in the body, this will mean fruitful labor for me. Yet what shall I choose? I do not know! 23 I am torn between the two: I desire to depart and be with Christ, which is better by far; 24 but it is more necessary for you that I remain in the body. Philippians 1:21-24

I grew up thinking that the purpose of Christianity was to become absent from a sinful, broken world and be with God. I'm glad that will be my situation in the future, but I am growing more convinced that this world needs my presence for many more years for the world's sake rather than my absence for mine.

Paul writes the church in Philippi that he struggles between wanting to go and be with Jesus (which is the most desirable option for him) and wanting to stay and keep ministering to them. What he concludes is that the place for him to be is present with the people who need what he has to offer and not absent from them to be with Jesus.

Jesus spent lots of his time in places and with people the religious leaders intentionally avoided. Their goal was to be absent from sinful people and situations to keep themselves clean. Jesus did the opposite. He went to places where sinful people were in sinful environments because they were the ones who needed him the most.

I can live the rest of my life on earth avoiding sinful people and sinful places, just spending time with the "right" people and getting ready to go to heaven. In other words – focus on being absent from the brokenness of the world. Or, I can fully invest the rest of my life in being present to sinful people in sinful places, giving hope to people who have been told they are the "wrong" people so I can be a conduit for heaven on earth. In other words – focus on being present to the needs of the world.

Jesus, I know the most desirable place is to be absent from this world and with you. Yet, I know

the place you have called me to be is present in this world of brokenness and sin for the sake of my neighbors. And, the amazing thing is that you will be present with me while I am present with them.

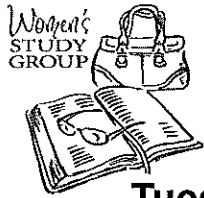
Join Pastor Mark and others from the Yukon community as we pray for each other and for the community.
