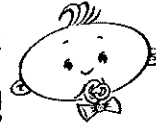

The Christmas season ends when Epiphany begins on **January 6**. While the colors for the first and last Sundays of Epiphany are white, the colors on the weeks in between are green. The first Sunday following Epiphany is observed as the Baptism of Our Lord, and the Last Sunday after the Epiphany is known as Transfiguration Sunday. 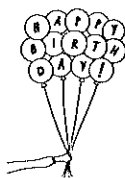
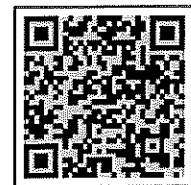

Pastor Mark's Remarks for February 2026
"Apprenticeship with Jesus"

"It is enough for the disciple to be like his teacher." Matthew 10:25

We often have way too small an understanding of what it means to be a Christian. It is more than intellectual. It is more than behavioral. It is relational. It is purposeful.

One of the first things Jesus does after his baptism is to start calling disciples. The last thing the resurrected Jesus says is to go and make disciples. If discipleship is so key to the Christian life, what exactly is it?

1. Discipleship is intellectual learning, but it is much more than that. Disciples are students who are taught information by a teacher but mastering that information does not make someone a disciple of Jesus.
2. Discipleship is doing what the master says to do but is much more than that. Disciples do what the Rabbi says to do, but following rules does not make someone a disciple of Jesus.
3. Discipleship is a relationship where we live our lives with our Rabbi, inviting him into every aspect of life. It is learning to think like the Rabbi, look like the Rabbi and do what the Rabbi does.

I think a better word for following Jesus than discipleship is apprenticeship. That word seems to do a better job of highlighting the relational aspect and the ultimate purpose of doing what the Rabbi does.

This Lent, you are invited to read the book *Practicing the Way* by John Mark Comer. In it, he invites the reader into what it means to be apprentices of Jesus. It is about more than learning information and following rules. It is primarily about three things:

1. Being with Jesus
2. Becoming like Jesus
3. Doing as Jesus did

The world needs more than Christians who believe things about Jesus and do things for Jesus. They need apprentices of Jesus who abide with Jesus until they look like him and do what he does...and then help others to do the same.

Are you ready to become his apprentice? If so, join us on the journey of Apprenticeship this Lent.
