**Pentecost 2025**

**June 8 – Nov 23**

Red is the color used on Pentecost Sunday. On this day we remember the power and fire of the Holy Spirit, "the Lord and Giver of Life." The color red communicates the motif of strength – the strength and power the Holy Spirit gives in order for God's people to call on the name of Jesus Christ and share that powerful name with others.

Pentecost begins fifty days after Easter. The season of Pentecost may last from 22 to 28 Sundays. Green is the appointed color for all but a few of these Sundays. The Sundays following Pentecost are called the season of the "green meadow," as these Sundays also emphasize the subject of growth.

**Pastor Mark's Remarks – September 2025**  
**"Living Fearless"**

*<sup>8</sup> For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—<sup>9</sup> not by works, so that no one can boast. <sup>10</sup> For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. Ephesians 2:8-10*

What if the Enemy wants you to believe lies about yourself and God, never address your brokenness, never hear what God thinks about you, and never live out God's calling for your life?

What if God wants to reveal the lies, bring healing, tell you who he sees you to be and lead you to live out the fulness of his purposes for your life?

The fact of the matter is that both of these statements are true. During the month of September, I will be doing a preaching series based on the book *Living Fearless* by Jamie Winship which will help to move you from living according to the Enemy's plans for your life and start living by God's plans.

There are four sections to the book, and I will preach on one section each week:

September 7 – "Attention" – The place to begin moving toward God's purposes for our lives is to notice where we are living according to lies rather than the truth. God wants to draw our attention to the lies which are destroying us so he can replace them with his truth.

September 14 – "Awareness" – Once God has gotten our attention that there is something wrong, it is time to start becoming aware of the ways the Enemy has brought destruction in our lives. As we become aware of the areas that need healing, we can give God access to bring that healing.

September 21 – "Annunciation" – Once we have given God access to expose the lies and heal the brokenness in our lives, the next step is to allow God to tell us who he sees us to be and who he is. As we have the lies replaced by truth it is time to replace the false identities we have allowed to define us with our true God-given identities.

September 28 – "Action" – Once we know who we were created to be and what we were created for, it is time to seek what God wants us to do.

If there is enough interest, Pastor Mark will get group tickets. The cost is \$5 plus ticket fees.

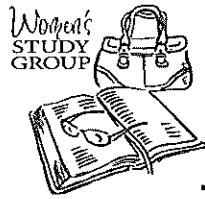
**LifeWise School-day Bible Class Coming to Yukon Public Schools!** –

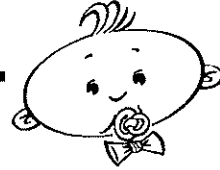

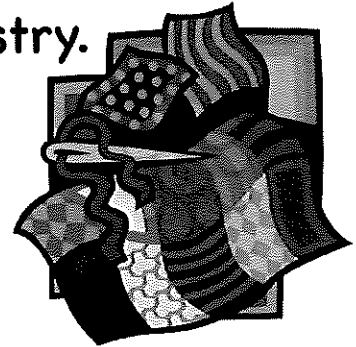
